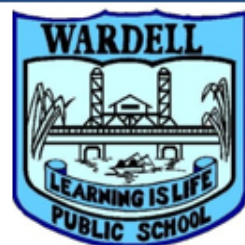

## Installation of fauna crossing on Wardell Road, Wardell

Roads and Maritime Services, Pacific Complete and its contractor partners are working together to deliver the Woolgoolga to Ballina Pacific Highway upgrade.

As part of the Koala Management Plan and Connectivity Strategy for the upgrade, the project team will install a fauna crossing (pipe culverts) at Wardell Road, Wardell. The culverts will connect into fauna fencing to control the movement of koalas and other wildlife near the highway.

To carry out this work, one way traffic will be in place on Wardell Road and managed under traffic control. The work will start in mid-June and is expected to take about four weeks to complete, weather permitting.
